

BEGINNER'S PATCHWORK

WITH EMMA RANDALL

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Class Description:

New to patchwork? Come along and learn the basics including rotary cutting, strip piecing and lots more. You can make your blocks into a quilt, table runner or cushion. You won't finish it on the day, but you will have the instructions to continue at home and you can book onto another class to carry on working on your project.

Fabric Requirements:

 If you have any fabric (ideally 100% cotton) you want to bring that would be a good starting point, otherwise our recommendation would be 1m by 110cm of main fabric/print and two 50cm by 110cm fabrics that go with the main one.

Equipment (if you have it):

- Notebook and pen
- If you have a rotary cutter, mat and ruler please bring these along; if not, we have some at the shop you can borrow.
- If you have a sewing kit, including scissors, pins, needles and threads, please bring them along.
- If you are bringing your own sewing machine don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles, plus your manual.

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible
