

Christmas Table Runner



Approx. finished size: 32" by 13"

Fabrics requirements:

30cm Red Fabric30cm Grey Scandi30cm Green Fabric30cm Red ScandiFat Quarter Cream fabricFat Quarter Grey stars

Cutting Instructions

From both the red and the green fabric you need to cut 6 pieces $10^{\prime\prime}$ x $3.25^{\prime\prime}$ From the cream fabric you need to cut 12 squares $3.25^{\prime\prime}$

Workshop Notes

It is assumed you will sew with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance; but so long as you are consistent the seam allowance doesn't really matter it will just affect the overall size of the table runner.

Sewing:

- Attach a cream square to one end of each of the red and the green fabric pieces.
- Lay these out above each other, ready for sewing, so that the cream squares alternate from the left hand side and right hand side.
- NB: if you have selected fabrics that are directional you may want to lay all the pieces out first before sewing anything together.
- Lay the pieces out as per your final design; you can then sew together in pairs and for those who like to strip pieces you can then sew the pairs together you will get 3 sets of 4 which are then sewn together to make the table runner.
- Press seams to one side.
