## Simple Take 5 Fabrics Block



This block was originally designed by Timeless Treasures but the setting has been changed by us.
Block Size: 10½"

## Requirements: (to make 9 blocks)

Fabric 1 - Fat Quarter
Fabric 2 - Fat Quarter
Fabric 3 - Fat Quarter
Fabric 4 - Fat Quarter
Fabric 5-75cm
Additional fabric will be needed for setting and borders

Cutting instructions: (per block)
Fabric 1: $\quad$ Rectangle $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric 2: Rectangle $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric 3: Rectangle $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric 4: Rectangle $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 /{ }^{\prime \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric 5: Rectangle $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$

Sewing sequence: (per block, using $1 / 4$ " seam allowance)
Sew fabric 1,2 and 3 together with 1 at the top, 2 in the middle and 3 at the bottom

Sew fabric 4 and 5 together, with 4 at the top and 5 below
Sew the two sections together

It's that easy!!

You can also attach blocks 1 to 3 to the right hand side for a change of layout. You can then use the blocks however you like.

For the quilt on the front page we chose to add sashing between the blocks and around the edge which was cut $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide.

For the quilt below we pieced the blocks without sashing then added a border (pink) cut $21 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " wide then a floral border to the sides and a different floral border to the top and bottom.

You could also try turning some of the blocks upside down or rotate them 45 degrees each time - just play with them and see how they look.
