

DELPHINE BROOKS PATTERNS

WITH ANITA BIRTLES

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Location: Creative Quilting, 32 Bridge Road, KT8 9HA

Class Description:

Why not try some beautiful raw edge appliqué this term. Anita will guide you through the process to make some of Delphine brooks patterns. Learn how to choose the colours to make the pattern stand out. Finishing with some free motion to highlight the wonderful appliqué.

Fabric & Materials Requirements:

- You will need to buy the pattern you wish to make we have a selection available in the shop. Please consult your pattern for the specific fabric requirements.
- If making a cushion, likely you will need:
 - 10" or 5" squares of patterned fabric (e.g. a Layer Cake or a Charm Pack) or scraps,
 - o 50cm plain fabric
 - o FQ of wadding
 - o 14" zip.
- If making a larger applique piece, likely you will need:
 - 10" or 5" squares of patterned fabric (e.g. a Layer Cake or a Charm Pack) or Fat Quarters.
 - o 1m background fabric

Equipment:

- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual)
- 1/4" foot and walking foot for your sewing machine
- Rotary cutter, large cutting mat & 6"x24" acrylic ruler
- Neutral thread for piecing (cream or grey are ideal)
- Threads for quilting
- Double-sided iron on adhesive (e.g Heat n Bond Lite)
- Spray adhesive (e.g. 505 spray) optional
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad, pen and propelling pencil.

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance - they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
