Have you made a Log Cabin Quilt and now want to expand to different shapes? Then come along to learn how to make Hexagon, Curvy or Wonky Log Cabin blocks. 24 Hexagon blocks makes this amazing quilt pictured but you can use just 6 blocks to make a table centrepiece.

## Equipment:

- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ foot for your sewing machine

- Rotary cutter, large cutting mat \& 6" $\times 24$ " acrylic ruler
- Neutral thread for piecing (cream or grey are ideal)
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad and pen
- If you have one, a 60 degree triangle ruler would be helpful for the Hexagon Log Cabin quilt. A Creative Grids Curvy Log Cabin Ruler is required for the Curvy Log Cabin, and a Creative Grids Wonky Log Cabin Ruler is required for the Wonky Log Cabin option.

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance - they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.

## Hexagon, Curvy and Wonky Log Cabin Quilts

Hexagon Log Cabin Quilt (approx. 80" by 92")


Either 2 Jelly Rolls (40x $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips per roll), OR 3 CQ Strip Rolls (20x 2.5 "strips per roll)
2.5 m background fabric

If you want to add corners to make the quilt square you will need an additional 2 m of background fabric.

If you have a 60 degree triangle ruler this will be useful.

## Curvy Log Cabin Quilt (approx. 58" by 74")



## 12 Fat Quarters

## Background 2.20 m white or cream

Border 140 cm
Border 2 1m
Creative Grids Curvy Log Cabin Ruler (available to buy in the shop)

## Wonky Log Cabin Quilt (approx. 40" by 50")



30 cm of 3 lighter fabrics (orange in the picture above)
60 cm of 3 darker fabrics (green/aqua in the picture above)
25 cm for centre squares and $1^{\text {st }}$ border
70 cm for $2^{\text {nd }}$ border
Creative Grids Wonky Log Cabin Ruler (available to buy in the shop)

## General Class Requirements

Sewing Machine (including manual and any feet you have - the $1 / 4$ " option is important)
Power cord and foot pedal for the machine (yes, they have been forgotten!)
Thread for piecing (neutral colours are best)
Rotary Cutter and 24" Ruler
Cutting Mat
General Sewing Kit (pins, scissors, notepad, pen etc.)
