Simple workshop Notes for Hickman Bag for St.George's Hospital



Cut piece of fabric for the bag 6" w x 7 ½" h

Turn over and neaten top edge (double fold and topstitch is fine) – this is the edge that is 7 %"

Make handle with your favourite method – no wadding needed: approx 30" long x 1" finished wide (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-3" cut strip of fabric works a treat)

Fix/sew one end of the handle to the top of the bag on the inside

Alongside add a piece of the hooky Velcro – approx 1" square will be fine

Now, to the other end of the handle add approx 2" of the soft side of the Velcro (remember to test position to ensure that it's on the correct face of the handle!)

Right sides together sew down the side and along the bottom of the bag

Turn right side out.

You are done!!!

NOTE: Handles ends need to be beside each other – not on opposite sides of the bag.
