

IRON CADDY

WITH ANITA BIRTLES

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Class Description:

Make this handy iron caddy. Ideal for taking to workshop as it transports your iron safely whilst doubling up as an ironing mat. The quilting is simple and easy to complete. Finishing off with a beautiful binding technique you might even learn to do beautiful mitred corners.

Fabric Requirements

You will need to buy the pattern you wish to make – either the Caddy Pad or the Caddy Pad Junior. This includes the heat resistant fabric needed. Please consult your pattern for the specific fabric requirements. As a guide, the following will be required:

Caddy Pad (for a large iron)

• 70cm fabric, 50cm binding fabric, 70cm wadding.

Caddy Pad Junior (for a small iron)

• 50cm fabric, 40cm binding fabric, 50cm wadding.

For both you will also need 2no. buttons, 20cm length of 0.25" wide elastic, 1m webbing for handle.

Equipment:

- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- 1/4" foot and walking foot for your sewing machine.
- Rotary cutter, large cutting mat & 6"x24" acrylic ruler
- Threads for piecing and quilting
- Wonder Clips
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Marking pens / chalk pens: need 2 types or colours.
- Notepad, pen and a propelling pencil

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
