Patchwork/Needlework does require time and patience so it is unlikely you will always finish the project during the workshop, although you will be given all the necessary instructions to complete it at home (Open Format and Follow-on workshops are also available to continue your project).

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**We have 6 Janome machines (M100 QDC) for students to hire during workshops, which are ideal if your machine is too heavy to carry upstairs.**

**The rental fee is only £5.00 per machine (for ½ or full day).**

**The machines are available on a first come, first serve basis.**

In addition to the T&Cs below please be aware that we may need to make changes to venues or cancel workshops at short notice (e.g. if a tutor is ill). Where possible we will give you as much notice as possible.

If you would like to book a place on a workshop...

- 1) Either ring the shop or return the enclosed booking form with full payment.
- 2) We cannot guarantee your space unless you pay for your place – **bookings received without payment will be put on a waiting list and only transferred to the actual workshop once they are paid for.**

This quilt brings together blocks made from a jelly roll and simple ice cream applique blocks. A bright quilt for the summer incorporating strip piecing, half square triangles, flying geese with fun applique corners. An opportunity to try free motion stitching on your applique and to try random placing of fabric.



Hand Embroidery Open Format with Becky Rowan – Level All

Scrappy Curvy Log Cabin with Anita Birtles – Level All

Using up strips of left over and scrap fabric. This quilt block is a take on the traditional log cabin but using 2 sizes of strips to form the curve illusion. Anita will show you how using the Creative Grids curvy log cabin trim tool (available to buy in the shop) makes this block simple to square up - giving accurate blocks every time.



Cushion Making Skills with Ann Avedian – Level All

Have you always wanted to make cushions? Learn how to make two small cushions with different fastening styles in the morning workshop.

The first cushion is a small rectangular cushion (suggested size 35 x 45 cm), with an invisible zip along the bottom edge. The second cushion is a square cushion with an overlapping envelope closing - with or without a button! Suggested size 40cm.

Sashiko is a country form of stitching from Japan. Described as fascinating, therapeutic and relaxing. Come and experience an introduction to this world of both embroidery and repair.

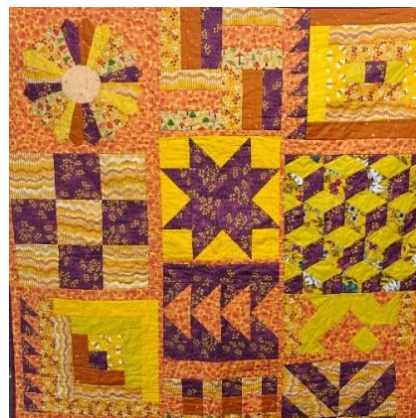
If you have not already attended a session here before, a starter kit with fabric, thread and a needle is necessary and is available to purchase from the shop on the day (£10).

This modern take on a sampler quilt uses a variety of piecing techniques to make up the blocks. From half square triangles, flying geese tumbling blocks, log cabin and a Dresden plate. The blocks are simply joined together in columns and quilted using a quilt as you go technique.

Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP) for Beginners with Emma Randall – Level All

Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP) is a quilting technique where you sew fabric pieces directly onto a printed paper template or foundation paper. It eliminates the struggle of matching complex seams, awkward angles, or tiny pieces. Because you are sewing directly on the printed lines, your points will always be sharp and perfectly aligned. Once you have mastered the basics with this simple star (you will be making 3 blocks for a table runner) you can move on to creating highly detailed, complex pictorial blocks (like animals, flowers, or geometric shapes) that would be nearly impossible to achieve using traditional cutting and piecing.

Stitch and Collage an Autumn Landscape with Ann Avedian – Level All

Wednesday 30th September 10.30am to 1.30pm £29.00

Use fabric remnants and simple hand embroidery stitches to make a small collage of an autumn landscape. Bring some of your own fabric scraps or use some of Ann's! Backing fabric and threads will be supplied.



Applique for Children's Quilts with Lizzy Stockwell – Level All

Saturday 3rd October 10.30am to 4.30pm £58.00

Come along to this workshop with Lizzy and learn how to make a beautiful applique quilt or fun play mat. Lizzy will cover the basic principles of raw edge machine applique, including her top tips. She can also guide you how to adapt patterns to add fun tactile elements.

You can either bring your own pattern or Lizzy recommends Kjersti Smith's patterns which are available to buy in the shop.



Make a Miniature Bear with Jan Simpson – Level All

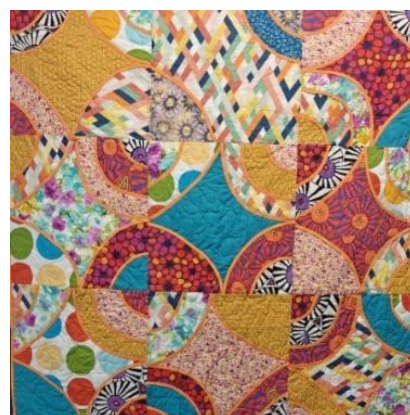
You will need to buy a kit from the tutor on the day (£10) you just need to bring some small needles, brown thread and your love of bears.

Quick Strip Christmas Tree with Anita Birtles – Level All

Pixelated Pictures with Emma Randall – Level All

Make this super easy pixelated picture using 1" squares without the faff of individually sewing together all those tiny pieces by using a squared interfacing and sewing complete rows in one go. This picture is from a free pattern by Tilda which requires 566 squares – using Emma's method means you can finish the picture (24" square) in a day!

Christmas Star with Cathy Bonner – Level Intermediate

Start getting ready for Christmas! Come along and learn how to make this stunning table mat to make a beautiful centrepiece for the table. It uses a pre-printed *Vlieseline* interfacing and is made in eight sections before being joined together. If you don't want to make it for Christmas, it makes a stunning table centrepiece all year round.



Scrap Tote Bag or Fleetwood Tote Bag with Anita Birtles– Level All

This fantastic colourful quilted, lined and zipped tote bag can be made using scraps. With a variety of techniques, Crumb netted, scrap pieced or even using left over charm squares or jelly roll strips. You will learn how to make and quilt your outer fabric. Adding webbing handles, zipped and a loose lining. This boxed bottom tote is an ideal shopper. Or bring along your fabrics and pattern for the Center Street Fleetwood Tote bag and Anita will get you started on that instead.



Stained Glass Christmas with Anita Birtles– Level Intermediate
