Intermediate =	someone with some knowledge, for patchwork this includes rotary cutting skills, ¼" seam allowance mastered and able to use a sewing machine.
Advanced =	someone with good patchwork skills

Reminder: - The class fee is due at the time of booking – It will be assumed that our terms and conditions below have been read and agreed when students book on our classes. A list of requirements for each class is available on the website approx. 2 weeks before the class, please check what you need to bring with you.

Patchwork/Needlework does require time and patience so it is unlikely you will always finish the project during the class, although you will be given all the necessary instructions to complete it at home (Open Format and Follow-on classes are also available to continue your project).

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We have 6 Janome machines (M100 QDC) for students to hire during classes, which are ideal if your machine is too heavy to carry upstairs.

The rental fee is only £5.00 per machine (for ½ or full day).

The machines are available on a first come, first serve basis.  
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Terms and Conditions

In addition to the T&Cs below please be aware that we may need to make changes to venues or cancel classes at short notice (e.g. if a tutor is ill). Where possible we will give you as much notice as possible.

If you would like to book a place on a class...

- 1) Either ring the shop or return the enclosed booking form with full payment.
- 2) We cannot guarantee your space unless you pay for your place – **bookings received without payment will be put on a waiting list and only transferred to the actual class once they are paid for.**
- 3) Should you wish to cancel - providing you give us **7 days notice** before the class, we will issue a CREDIT NOTE. It can be used against goods or classes and there is no time limit on it. However, **if you do not give us 7 days notice we will NOT BE ABLE to issue a credit note** as we would have confirmed the tutor and committed to pay their fee. We will be happy for you to find someone to take your place, but we cannot take responsibility to find someone for you.
- 4) Should WE cancel a class, a full refund (via original payment method) or class credit (if you prefer) will be given.

We will assume T&Cs have been read and agreed when you book on a class.

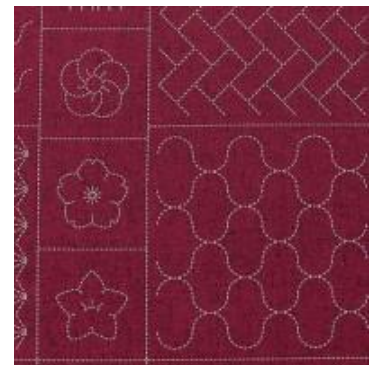
Sashiko for Beginners with Daphne Morris – Level All

Sashiko is a country form of stitching from Japan. Described as fascinating, therapeutic and relaxing. Come and experience an introduction to this world of both embroidery and repair.

If you have not already attended a session here before, a starter kit with fabric, thread and a needle is necessary and is available to purchase on the day (£10).



Rainbow Strip Project Bag with Daphne Morris – Level All

A fun bag using 2 1/2" strips and a co-ordinating fabric with a box construction for the base and sides. This bag lends itself to a variety of quilting styles, especially if your machine offers embroidery stitches.

Foundation Paper Piecing Geo Hexies with Emma Randall – Level All

These colourful hexagons are made using the Foundation Paper Piecing technique – it gives crisp points and the shapes are easier to make than traditional piecing – and no Y seams! **You will need to purchase a pattern** which will give you two styles (regular like this sample and Flying Geese) in three different sizes. Make 9 blocks for a quilt or try just 1 block for a cushion.

Make your own Lampshade with Ann Avedian – Level All

You will also need to purchase a Kit - available to order (when you book this class) for £17.50

Learn how to make a basic small drum lampshade, using one of the beautiful fabrics we sell in the shop. This course, across two mornings, will give you the skills to move onto making different sizes and shapes of lampshade. There is no sewing on this course, but Ann will discuss ways that you can use collage, patchwork and sashiko to create original fabrics to cover your future shades, and make them absolutely unique.

You can also make the blocks into a play mat/quilt if you prefer. Or make a single page into a teether/comforter with tactile items including ribbons and silicone teethers.

Dog and Bone with Anita Birtles – Level All

This quilt incorporates 3 techniques to make this beautiful picture blocks. Piecing for the puppy, Foundation paper piecing for the bone and applique for the paws. How big you make the quilt is up to you - small for your K9 friend or large to fit your bed.

Walking Foot Quilting with Emma Randall – Level All

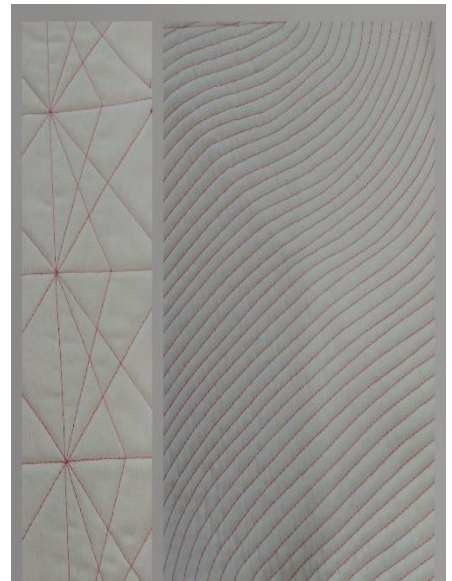

If you are new to dressmaking you will probably need to book a follow on session on one of Cathy's Open Format dates.



Scrap Patch Bag with Anita Birtles - Level All

A true crumb technique making fabric to use in a bag or book cover. No piece of fabric is too small for this project. Learn how to layer up the crumbs and turn them into a whole piece of fabric. Your unique piece of fabric can then be made into fantastic tote with a loose lining and pockets.



Pop Open Pouch (from Aneela Hoey) with Emma Randall – Level All

Do you like making bags? Then come along to this class and learn how to make this easy bag.
