Categories:

- All = anyone, no knowledge or experience needed
- Intermediate = someone with some knowledge, for patchwork this includes rotary cutting skills, ¼" seam allowance mastered and able to use a sewing machine.
- Advanced = someone with good patchwork skills

Reminder: - The class fee is due at the time of booking – It will be assumed that our terms and conditions below have been read and agreed when students book on our classes. A list of requirements for each class is available on the website approx. 2 weeks before the class, please check what you need to bring with you.

Patchwork/Needlework does require time and patience so it is unlikely you will always finish the project during the class, although you will be given all the necessary instructions to complete it at home (Open Format and Follow-on classes are also available to continue your project).

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We have 6 Janome machines (M100 QDC) for students to hire during
classes, which are ideal if your machine is too heavy to carry upstairs.
The rental fee is only £5.00 per machine (for ½ or full day).
The machines are available on a first come, first serve basis.
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Terms and Conditions

In addition to the T&Cs below please be aware that we may need to make changes to venues or cancel classes at short notice (e.g. if a tutor is ill). Where possible we will give you as much notice as possible.

If you would like to book a place on a class...

- 1) Either ring the shop or return the enclosed booking form with full payment.
- 2) We cannot guarantee your space unless you pay for your place – **bookings received without payment will be put on a waiting list and only transferred to the actual list once paid for.**
- 3) Should you wish to cancel - providing you give us **7 days notice** before the class, we will issue a CREDIT NOTE. It can be used against goods or classes and there is no time limit on it. However, **if you do not give us 7 days notice we will NOT BE ABLE to issue a credit note** as we would have confirmed the tutor and committed to pay their fee. We will be happy for you to find someone to take your place, but we cannot take responsibility to find someone for you.
- 4) Should WE cancel a class, a full refund (via original payment method) or class credit (if you prefer) will be given.

Beginner Patchwork Quilt with Cathy Bonner – Level All

New to patchwork? Come along and learn the basics including rotary cutting, strip piecing and lots more. You can make your blocks into a quilt, table runner or cushion. You won't finish it on the day, but you will have the instructions to continue at home and you can book onto another class to carry on working on your project.

Dressmaking with Cathy Bonner - Level Intermediate

Thursday 18th January 10.30am to 4.00pm (earlier finish time) £43

Come and join Cathy who can guide you through dressmaking patterns. Cathy loves the patterns from Merchant and Mills and they are great for beginners. You will need to purchase any pattern you want to use before the class. We recommend the Merchant & Mills website (merchantandmills.com) and love the Hattie and Factory dresses. If you are new to dressmaking you will probably need two sessions.



Simple Foundation Paper Pieced Cushion with Anita Birtles – Level Intermediate

Friday 26th January 10.30am to 4.30pm £47



Learn the techniques of foundation paper piecing. Make accurate shapes using printed papers and your sewing machine. This simple introduction will get you hooked and enable you to go onto making more complicated pictures.

Rose Shadow Quilting Hand Embroidery with Vicky O'Leary – Level All

Tuesday 30th January 10.30am to 2.30pm £31.50

Learn how to create this beautifully simple rose design using embroidery based on a shadow quilting technique. The embroidery part is very therapeutic and mindful and gives you a chance to focus on something other than your to do list! You can embellish with additional beads/stitches once finished. You can choose your own colours for the background/rose and leaf fabrics to create something more muted or more vibrant. The finished piece is 21x30cm. This can be used as a centre for a cushion/quilt or as a framed piece.



Free Motion Quilting with Anita Birtles – Level All

Ever wondered how to quilt your quilt. Will it highlight the patchwork, hide the matching points, enhance the fussy cutting or just get it finished? Free Motion Quilting, Walking foot Quilting, Ruler work or machine tying, learn the quilting method that works for your quilt.



He Loves Me, He Loves Me Knot with Wendy Mansfield – Level All

Tuesday 6th February 10.30am to 4.30pm £47



This is the first of eight hand applique designs based on flora. You will learn how to applique sheer fabric to a silk background and cutline with metal threads. You will also be using couching, backstitch and split stitch. A kit will be supplied on the day which will have everything you need to complete the project.

You will be working with a free-standing embroidery hoop which will be provided on the day so you will need to bring an 8" OR 10" embroidery hoop with you to transfer your project into at the end of the day.

There will be cost of £10.00 for the kit which needs to be given to tutor on the day.

Easy Does it Bag with Anita Birtles – Level All

Friday 9th February 10.30am to 4.30pm £47

A great introduction to By Annie patterns. Learn simple quilting, adding zips and binding. The beautiful bag produced can store and carry all your essentials. Why not add a vinyl lining to make a hand wash bag.



Trip Around the World with Cathy Bonner – Level Intermediate

Wednesday 14th February 10.30am to 16.30pm £47



A classic quilting design, this pattern is easier to make than you think, and doesn't require you to cut lots of small pieces! You can use yardage (fat quarters are ideal), jelly roll or strip roll or scraps.

Get to Know your Sewing Machine with Cathy Bonner – Level All

Thursday 15th February 10.30am to 4.00pm (earlier finish time) £43

This is an ideal opportunity to get to know your sewing machine, its functions, accessories and capabilities. Understanding your sewing machine will enhance your sewing experience and build your confidence as you learn how to get the most from your sewing machine. You will also learn some simple piecing and rotary cutting plus lots of tips from Cathy!



Lone Star with Emma Randall – Level Intermediate

Come and learn how to make this classic design without having to cut and match lots of diamonds and with minimal sewing on the bias. Depending on the size strips you use you can make it into a quilt or wall hanging.



Hare Machine Embroidery with Vicky O’Leary – Level Intermediate

Friday 23rd February 10.30am to 2.30pm £31.50

Learn how to sew this beautiful hare. It’s a great project to use up your scrap fabrics. You can embellish the piece by adding your own stitching to create some grasses and flowers in the foreground. This piece is created using free machine embroidery with an embroidery foot and lowering the feed dog, bring your own machine along (with the embroidery foot) or hire one. The finished piece is 22x30cm. This can be used as a centre for a cushion/quilt or as a framed piece, even wrapped around a frame if you use a larger background fabric.



Quick Strip Baby Quilt with Anita Birtles – Level Intermediate

Tuesday 5th March 10.30am to 4.30pm £47



This baby quilt is quick and easy to make with stunning results. Using scraps and 2 ½ inch strips this quilt is ideal for using up left over fabric. You will learn to make **till roll crumb strips**, join strips without curving, and appliqué a beautiful motif to personalise for a new baby. Simple quilting techniques such as machine tying will complete your quilt.



Skill Building with Cathy Bonner – Level All

Wednesday 13th March 10.30am to 16.30pm £47



Add to your patchwork and quilting skill base by mastering chain piecing and strip piecing. Also learn how to make half square triangles, quarter square triangles and pinwheels accurately and precisely to produce neat and sharp points and explore the different ways to use these techniques. Snowball blocks and flying geese are also versatile and useful blocks to have in your patchwork ‘tool bag’. Come and join us for a really useful class to improve and enhance your patchwork and quilting experience.

Bags, Bags, Bags! with Cathy Bonner – Level Intermediate

Thursday 14th March 10.30am to 4.00pm (earlier finish time) £43



You can choose from a number of different bags, from Emmaline through to tote. Learning how to put zips in and easy ways to do things, these pretty bags are fun to sew, can normally be finished in a day and make fantastic gifts, perfect for friends of all ages.



Scrap Crazy 6 with Anita Birtles – Level Intermediate

Friday 22nd March 10.30am to 4.30pm £47

A simple crazy block using scraps and templates. Ideal for those of you that adore the look of improv quilting but need a more uniform way to produce a quilt. There are no limits other than the scraps you have in your stash.



Hexagon Log Cabin with Emma Randall – Level Advanced

Saturday 23rd March 10.30am to 4.30pm £47



Have you made a Log Cabin Quilt and now want to expand to different shapes? Then come along to learn how to make a Hexagon Log Cabin block – 24 blocks makes this amazing quilt but you can use just 6 blocks to make a table centrepiece.

Re-use, Re-cycle and Re-lax! with Wendy Mansfield – Level All

Tuesday 26th March 10.30am to 4.30pm £47

Slow stitching is a new term for an age-old practice of quiet gentle making and stitching, combining a range of different forms of hand stitching, taking influence from Japanese Boro and Sashiko, Indian Kantha and European Embroidery. There is no design to follow, just go at your own speed and enjoy the day. You will be using a range of recycled everyday items to create your masterpiece.



A kit will be supplied on the day which will have everything you need to complete the project including an embroidery hoop.

There will be cost of £10.00 for the kit which needs to be given to tutor on the day.

Pineapple Quilts with Emma Randall – Level Intermediate

Friday 5th April 10.30am to 4.30pm £47



Using the Creative Grids Pineapple Ruler (available in the shop) Emma will guide you through making these blocks, including thinking about colour placements and using dark or light backgrounds. If you prefer you can make an easier version (see class requirements online for details).



Foundation Paper Piecing with Cathy Bonner – Level Intermediate

Wednesday 10th April 10.30am to 4.30pm £47

Many of you may be put off by the labour-intensive cutting and fitting process that makes some complicated looking quilt blocks. Foundation piecing takes all the hassle out of cutting and sewing your quilt block. You can even use oddly shaped pieces of fabric scraps without extra cutting. Turn your piece into a cushion, quilt or tote bag.



Blackwork Flower with Wendy Mansfield – Level All

Tuesday 16th April 10.30am to 4.30pm £47



An introduction to Blackwork embroidery. Using a counted thread technique with a variety of geometric stitched patterns using one colour thread. Suitable for beginners, this design is created using blackwork stitches and goldwork metal threads on an open weave fabric.

A kit will be supplied on the day (cost £10 payable direct to the tutor) which will have everything you need to complete the project. You may wish to bring a magnifier if you have one.

You will be working with a free-standing embroidery hoop which will be provided on the day so you will need to bring an 8" OR 10" embroidery hoop with you to transfer your project into at the end of the day.

Oxeye Daisies Machine Embroidery with Vicky O'Leary – Level All

Tuesday 23rd April 10.30am to 2.30pm £31.50

Learn how to create a lovely textured piece using green fabrics and organza, complete with two oxeye daisies all machine sewn. Learn how to couch threads for the stems and add a colourful centre to the flowers.

You can create this piece using free machine embroidery with an embroidery foot and lowering the feed dog or with normal machine stitching. The finished piece is 20x30cm. This can be used as a centre for a cushion/quilt or as a framed piece.

There is a cost of £3 for a kit of green, white and yellow fabrics plus organza and a background green fabric, please see the list of other items that you need to bring on the day (online).
