Class Description:

Have you ever thought of making a quilt or cushion but then changed your mind because it mentions the dreaded Y Seams? If so this class is for you - come along and get to grips with the Y Seams technique with Emma's help and either make a few blocks into a cushion or go big and make a quilt.

Fabric & Materials Requirements (for a quilt):

- 1.5m black fabric
 - 1m light grey or light blue fabric
- The black and light fabric need not be very different to each other, so you get the 3D effect.*
- 110 pieces of fabric minimum 2.5" by 5" up to 3" by 6"
Emma used all scraps but as a guide you would get approx. 18 pieces from a Fat Quarter.
 - 25cm for narrow border (blue in the picture)

Equipment:

- Either
 - A sheet of template plastic OR
 - A 2" Half Hexagon acrylic template with 1/4" seam allowance and a 2" 60 degree Diamond acrylic template with 1/4" seam allowance.
- Rotary cutter, large cutting mat & 24" acrylic ruler
- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- 1/4" foot for your sewing machine
- Neutral thread for piecing (cream or grey are ideal)
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad and pen

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
