



FREE FORM QUILTS

WITH ANITA BIRTLES

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Class Description:

Want to use up those odd fat quarters and try a free form curve technique? This improv quilt uses a rotary cutter to form bold curves and bias binding techniques to highlight the curves. These large blocks form a fantastically modern and unique quilt.

Requirements:

- 12no. Fat Quarters
- 1m fabric for binding & bias binding

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic ruler (6" by 24").
- Sewing machine: don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual. *(Yes, power lead and foot pedal have been forgotten, do check you have yours!)*
- Sewing machine feet: please bring a 1/4" foot
- Thread for piecing (neutral colours are best)
- Thread for topstitching (to match you binding fabric)
- General sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc.)
- Propelling pencil.

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
