



SCRAP FABRIC TOTE BAG

WITH ANITA BIRTLES

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Class Description:

This fantastic colourful quilted, lined and zipped tote bag can be made using scraps. With a variety of techniques, Crumb netted, scrap pieced or even using left over charm squares or jelly roll strips. You will learn how to make and quilt your outer fabric. Adding webbing handles, zipped and a loose lining. This boxed bottom tote is an ideal shopper. Or bring along your fabrics and pattern for the Center Street Fleetwood Tote bag and Anita will get you started on that instead

Requirements (for a Scrap Fabric Tote):

- ½ m lining fabric
- 60cm bag zip
- 2x 17" squares wadding
- 2x 17" squares of HeatnBond
- 2x 17" square of tulle or netting
- 3m webbing for bag handle

Requirements (for a Fleetwood Tote bag):

- Your own Center Street Quilts Fleetwood Tote pattern
- All fabric requirements as per the Fleetwood Tote.

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic ruler (6" by 24").
- Sewing machine: don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. **feet***, bobbins, needles* plus your manual & stitch guide (yes, power lead and foot pedal have been forgotten, do check you have yours!).

*** You will need a ¼" foot, a walking foot and. Zipper foot for your sewing machine.**

- Clips
- Threads for piecing
- Threads for quilting
- General sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc.)
- Notepad and propelling pencil

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
