



SCRAP QUILTS

WITH ANITA BIRTLES

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Class Description:

Learn a variety of techniques for using up scraps, from scrap squares, till roll piecing to crumb techniques. How the blocks go together is then your choice. Make a full illusion quilt, use blocks to make a scrap sampler or combine with a solid fabric to highlight your scraps.

Fabric & Materials Requirements:

For the Till Roll Piecing:

- Scraps! Either from your stash, scrap bags or charm packs.
- A till roll (will be available to buy from the shop)

For the Illusion Quilt:

- Scraps of fabric sorted into colour coordinated bags
You'll need enough of each colour to cover a 10" area once you've allowed for seams. Have a bag of coordinated scraps for each block you wish to make.
- 0.5m plain, dark fabric (grey or black)
- 1m plain, neutral fabric for background

Equipment:

- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual)
- 1/4" foot for your sewing machine
- Rotary cutter, large cutting mat and acrylic ruler
- If you have them, a 10" (or above) square ruler and/or a *Stripology Squared* ruler.
- Neutral thread for piecing (cream or grey are ideal)
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad, pen and propelling pencil.

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
