Class Description:

Ever wondered how to make your quilt look as though you are looking through a window at a landscape? Then come along to this class with Sue and she will show you how. This technique works best with a panel but can also look stunning with floral fabrics or as an "I Spy" quilt for children.

Fabric Requirements:

- Scenic panel or other fabric for "windows" e.g. flowers or animals for an "I Spy" quilt.
- For window "frames": 0.5m light coloured fabric & 0.5m dark coloured fabric.
- 0.5m black fabric for sashing – or more if you want a wider border.
- 1.5m backing fabric*
- 1.0m wadding*

**may not need on the day, but will be needed to finish your project.*

Equipment:

- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- 1/4" foot for your sewing machine
- Neutral sewing thread for piecing
- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic 6" by 24" ruler
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Marking pen or chalk pen
- Notepad and pen (ideally a propelling pencil)

Please remember:

- To wear a face covering / mask or face shield when moving around the classroom & in the shop.
- That the windows will be kept open during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible (including a travel mug if you have one).
