## Blue Escape Quilt Workshop Notes



Approx. finished size: 50" by 70"

This quilt is made using $10^{\prime \prime}$ squares, it would make a stunning scrap quilt too.

## Fabrics requirements:

$1 \times 20$ fabric layer cake
1 m sashing fabric
$1^{\text {st }}$ border fabric -50 cm
$2^{\text {nd }}$ border fabric $-1 m$

## Workshop Notes

Make 15 blocks as follows:
Cut the layer cake into 5 " squares.
Cut the sashing fabric into pieces $5^{\prime \prime}$ by $2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 2" squares for centre pieces - Val used one of the fabrics from the layer cake and there was enough for all the 15 blocks as well as the main sashing squares.
Place 4 of the $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares and add 4 sashing strips and the centre piece as shown in picture.

Create as much variety as possible with the 5 " squares.


Make 15; press and measure (make a note of this for the next step).

Set the blocks $3 \times 5$ in a pleasing manner and then cut 10 strips of sashing strips $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ wide by your measurement (from above). Sew the sashing to the blocks as shown below:

Repeat for all 5 rows.
You will then ned to cut 12 strips of sashing strips $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ wide by your measurement (from above) and 8 cornerstones @ 2.5" square - Val used the same layer cake fabric selection as before.

Make 4 horizontal sashing strips:


Then join rows together with the horizontal sashing strips.


Add $1^{\text {st }}$ border - you will need to measure your top as shown by blue lines and cut border $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ by this measurement - and add cornerstones ( 2.5 " squares) made from the layer cake fabric.

Add $2^{\text {nd }}$ border strips - cut at $5^{\prime \prime}$ you will need 6 strips and cornerstones (from the layer cake).
Layer, quilt and bind.
