



Autum Days Quilt



Approx. finished size: 42" square

Fabrics requirements:

1 panel
1m background fabric
Fat ¼ of print
50cm - 1st Border and binding

Workshop Notes

Cut out the 4 large squares at 10.5"

You will need to make 5 stars to compliment this:

Cut out small squares accurately at 4.5" and select the 5 you want to work with – these will be your centre squares.

Per Star Block:

you will need one centre square; 4 corners cut at 2.5" and 8 HST units made with the background fabric and print using your favourite method.

Press

Add 2" strips background fabric on all 4 sides

Press

Trim to 10.5" so they are the same size as the printed picture panels.



Set quilt out as per picture - sew rows together.

Add 1st border : (striped border in photo)

Cut 4 strips @ 2.5" – add to the top, bottom and two sides, cutting to size.

Add 2nd Border – this is created using the rectangular pictures from the panel:

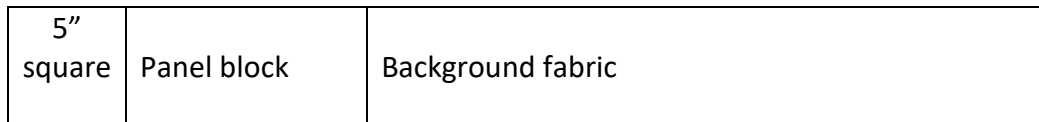
Cut them out accurately leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance around – which means they should be 5" wide.

Cut 4 strips of background fabric at 5" – from two strips cut a 5" square and put aside.

Join two of the rectangle panels to two of the border strips and attach to the top and bottom of the quilt, trim the background fabric to fit.



Use the other rectangle panels and background border strips to create your side borders – taking care that the rectangular picture panels are where you want them. You will add the two 5" squares to the side of the panel to make the full border piece. Trim the longer piece of background fabric to make it fit the quilt.



Press well.

Layer, quilt and bind.

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
