



# Charm Pack Quilt Pattern

Size 103cm by 94cm approx.

## Requirements/Included:

1x Moda Charm pack (or 42 x 5" squares)  
30cm of 2 different fabrics for borders  
30cm of Binding fabric  
1m of Backing fabric  
Wadding 1m10cm by 1m20cm

## Instructions:

**Always use 1/4" seam allowance.**

1. Lay the 5" squares out in the desired pattern, you will have a design that is 6 blocks by 7 blocks. Sew together in rows.
2. Press the seam in the first row all going in the same direction, then press the seams in the second row in the opposite direction, continue this for the rest of the rows. This will make it easier for the seams to sit together when you are joining the rows together.
3. Join the rows together by putting both right sides of fabric together, pin the seams so that they match and sit neatly together and sew. Continue until all the rows are joined together and you have a centre block of 6 by 7 squares.
4. From the 2 different border fabrics cut 2.5" strips, you will need 4 x 2.5" strips from each fabric.
5. Measure the 2 long sides of your block (mine came to 32") chose your first border fabric and cut 2 of the 2.5" strips down to the measurement you have just taken.
6. Join these 2 strips to the long sides of your quilt, I pin both ends and put a few pins between so that the strip fits well. Press the seams towards the edge of your quilt top.
7. Then measure the other 2 sides which were the shorter sides, and again using the first border fabric cut down the other 2 x 2.5" strips to your measurement and sew these on to your quilt. Press the seams towards the edge of your quilt top.
8. Repeat steps 5 to 7 with the second border fabric, always measuring the side to check the cutting measurements. I again joined the longer sides first, then measured and joined the second 2 pieces to the shorter sides.
9. This is now your finished quilt top, press well.
10. Layer up the quilt top, wadding and backing fabric and quilt as desired.
11. Cut your binding fabric to your desired width (I like to have mine at 2"), join the strips together.
12. Join the binding to the quilt in your preferred method.
