

Dahlia Quilt - Requirements

Small Dahlia - 20 inch square.

Can be made larger with additional borders



7 fabrics for the petals - a fat quarter of each is fine (half that for the inner petals).

Background fabric - $\frac{1}{2}$ metre

Additional border (optional) - another $\frac{1}{2}$ metre.

If you want to turn this into a cushion or wall hanging you will need wadding and backing fabric. Calculate how wide a border you want and cut your wadding and backing accordingly.

Large Dahlia - 38" square.

Can be made to whatever size you wish with additional borders.



Fabric 1 - Centre of Dahlia - Fat quarter or less

Fabric 2 - Fat quarter

Fabric 3 - Fat quarter

Fabric 4 - Fat quarter

Fabric 5 - $\frac{1}{2}$ metre

Fabric 6 - $\frac{1}{2}$ metre

Fabric 7 - 0.75 metre

Fabric 8 - Fat quarter

Fabric 9 - 2 metres

If you want to add borders you might want to buy more of some of these fabrics. You would need at least a metre, maybe a metre and a half for plain borders. If you want to do something a little more 'designed' contact me and we'll work it out.

Wadding - 1.5 metres of 60" wide

Backing - 1.25 metres (if your quilt is staying at 38 inches square)

If you're adding borders, let me know how big your finished quilt is likely to be and I'll let you know how much backing fabric.

You'll also need thread for piecing and thread for quilting.
