Class Description:

Do you want to learn an alternative way of finishing your binding? Why not try Flange or Faux Piping binding? This is a quilt finishing technique that mimics the look of piped edges without the bulk. It creates a tiny, colourful (or plain) accent strip (the flange) along the inner edge of the binding.

Requirements:

- A quilt that has been quilted but not bound.
- 2 different fabrics for binding – you should calculate how much you need based on 2" strips. If you need help calculating how much you need, then email the shop with the size of your quilt and Emma will tell you how you will need. As a guide 2x 50cm fabrics will be plenty for a 60" square quilt.

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic ruler (6" by 24").
- Sewing machine: don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet (see below), bobbins, needles, plus your manual (yes, *power lead and foot pedal have been forgotten, do check you have yours!*)
- Feet: a 1/4" foot and a walking foot for your machine.
- Threads: *you will be finishing the binding by machine so bring a thread you are happy to see on the front (and back) of the quilt.*
- General sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc.)
- Notepad and pen

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
