Class Description:

Using the 60 degree cutting line on a ruler or a 60 degree ruler make this statement Spinning Star quilt. It uses just five different fabrics plus a background, and you can easily adjust the size if you don't want such a big quilt. There is some work needed in advance for you to get the most out of the class (see following pages).

Requirements:

- 1m of 4 different fabrics (Emma used light blue through to dark blue)
- ½ m accent fabric (Emma used pink)
- 4m background fabric

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic ruler (6" by 24").
- 24.5" ruler with 60 degree marking
- Sewing machine: don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet (a ¼" foot option is important), bobbins, needles plus your manual (yes, *power lead and foot pedal have been forgotten, do check you have yours!*)
- Thread for piecing (neutral colours are best)
- General sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc.)
- Notepad and pen

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
- Please read the terms and conditions (under "Classes and Demonstrations" on our website).

Pre Class Preparation to get the most out of the class (if you have time!)

Cutting

Cut 10x 2½“ strips from each of the Blue, Purple, Lilac and White fabrics

Cut 4x 2½“ strips from the Pink fabric

Making Strip Sets

Join 10 sets of strips using the Blue, Purple, Lilac and White fabrics, making sure they are all identical. Press seams open.

Tip: It is important that you sew alternate rows in opposite directions otherwise your rows may start to curve one way and resemble a banana.



Take 2 of the strip sets and sew a Pink strip next to the White side of each strip set. Press the seams open. Label these Strip Set A



Take another 2 strip sets and sew a Pink strip to the Blue side of the strip sets and press the seams open. Label these Strip Set B
