



# Fast Flying Geese (no waste method)

For geese that are 4" x 2" finished you will need to cut:  
(you will make 4 geese from the following)

One square of goose fabric 5 1/4" square  
4 squares of sky (background) fabric 2 7/8"

Place two squares of the sky fabric right side down onto the goose fabric, in opposing corners matching up the raw edges - pin securely.

Draw a line across the diagonal (to be the cutting line) and then either side of it a sewing line that is 1/4" away (unless you have an ACCURATE patchwork foot)

Sew along these lines

Cut on the diagonal line you first drew (i.e. between your rows of stitching.)

Press

\*\*Onto the remaining corner of each piece, place a square of sky (right side down) - draw the diagonal as before and the sewing lines.

Sew along the sewing lines  
cut between the sewing lines  
press.

Repeat from \*\* with the remaining piece of patchwork.

You now have 4 flying geese - sew together in rows as required.

If you want to produce geese that are 8" x 4" the cutting measurements are  
goose - 9 1/4" square (need 1)  
sky - 4 7/8" (need to cut four)
