

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

WITH FMMA RANDALL

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Location: Creative Quilting, 32 Bridge Road, KT8 9HA

Class Description:

Come and learn how to make fast half square triangles (HSTs) and avoid cutting and sewing on the bias. Once you've mastered the technique you can make a variety of different designs with your HST blocks. Emma will share some of these designs with you.

Fabric & Materials Requirements:

This will vary depending upon the design chosen:

Starburst (68" square)

- 1m dark purple
- ¾m light purple
- 1m mid purple
- 1m blue
- 2m background

Hunter's Star (50" by 82")

- 2.25m cream
- 2.25m purple

Spiral (40" square)

- 60no. 5" squares of patterned fabrics
- 1.5m background fabric

Wadding, backing and binding - measure your finished quilt top to determine how much you need.

Equipment:

- Small square ruler (6½" is perfect)
- Rotary cutter, large cutting mat & 24" acrylic ruler
- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- Neutral thread for piecing (cream or grey are ideal)
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad and pen

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
