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**Location: Creative Quilting,
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Class Description:

This Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP) technique makes complex piecing simple. Learn new tips and techniques for curved piecing producing a stunning block that can be made into a beautiful cushion or bigger quilt.

Fabric Requirements

- 1m background fabric
- A variety of coordinating Fat Quarters (FQ) – min. 8no.

To finish:

- 0.5m border fabric
- 0.5m binding fabric
- 1m wadding
- 1m backing fabric

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic ruler.
- An "Add a Quarter" ruler
- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- Walking foot for your sewing machine.
- Threads for piecing.
- Glue pen, e.g. Sewline Glue Pen.
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad, pen and a propelling pencil
- Optionally, Anita recommends the book "New York Beauties and Flying Geese" by Carl Hentsch (available from SearchPress: use code **DD35** for a 20% discount plus FREE P&P).

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
