## Class Description:

Using the Creative Grids Pineapple ruler (available in the shop) Emma will guide you through making these blocks, including thinking about colour placements and setting on point. Emma will have different quilts for you to choose from.

## Fabric & Materials Requirements:

- The fabric requirements for each of the different quilts are attached in the following pages.

## Equipment:

- Creative Grids "Pineapple" Ruler
- Rotary cutter, large cutting mat & 24" acrylic ruler
- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- 1/4" foot for your sewing machine
- Neutral thread for piecing (cream or grey are ideal)
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad and pen

The following would be useful if you have them:

- 2.5" by 12" ruler (for the scrappy quilt)
- 12" rotating cutting mat or smaller cutting mat for trimming after each round.

## Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.

# Pineapple Quilts

You have the option of 4 different quilts, they all use the same technique and ruler and if you want to adjust the size\* feel free to do so.

**Due to the size of the strips, these pineapple quilts do not really work with big print fabrics. The best fabrics to choose are small prints or batiks.**

## Beginner Pineapple Quilt (approx. 36" by 44")



This quilt is formed of twelve 8" blocks plus three borders. You will need:

30cm each of 10 colours

**OR**

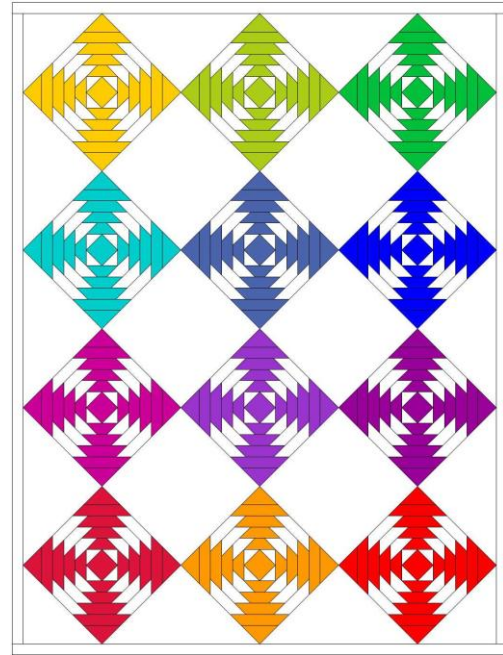
1 jelly roll (but there is quite a bit of waste using this option)

For both options you will also need 1.5m background (white or cream)

Borders - the above requirements allow for scrappy borders as per the picture, if you want a single border you will need a further 75cm border fabric.

\*Adjusting the size - as a very rough guide, we would allow an extra 5" (15cm) by width of fabric of background and 5" (15cm) by width of fabric feature fabrics per extra block.

## Intermediate Modern Pineapple Quilt (approx. 55" by 70")



For this 10" squares quilt you will need:

12 long quarters (fat quarters would be ok too, you just need to concentrate more!)

4m black/grey or white/cream background fabric

## Advanced Pineapple Circles Quilt (approx. 45" by 56")



For this rainbow quilt made with 8" blocks you will need:

5m background fabric

20cm Colour 1 (top left)

50cm Colour 2

1m Colour 3

1.4m Colour 4

1.25m Colour 5

75cm Colour 6

30cm Colour 7 (bottom right)

## Scrappy Pineapple Quilt (approx. 56" by 72")



An ideal project to use up scraps! Although if you don't like random this one probably isn't for you. **You will need the equivalent of approximately 192 strips 2" by width of fabric to make a quilt this size plus 4 strips of 2½" by width of fabric for centres.** These requirements are a guide, we do not expect you to measure your scraps; just bring along all your scraps that are between 2" and 2.5" wide (wider is fine but you will be cutting them down) and at least 8" long. You can always add in some extra fat quarters if you don't have a broad range of colours.

1m Border fabric

### General Class Requirements

Creative Grids Pineapple Ruler

Sewing Machine (including manual and any feet you have – the ¼" option is important)

Power cord and foot pedal for the machine (yes, they have been forgotten!)

Thread for piecing (neutral colours are best)

Rotary Cutter and 24" Ruler

Cutting Mat

General Sewing Kit (pins, scissors, pens, notepad etc.)

Also, if you have one the following might be useful:

12" Rotating Cutting Mat or smaller cutting mat for trimming after each round
