



ENGLISH PAPER PIECING (EPP) FESTIVE SPECIAL

WITH BECKY ROWAN

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Class Description:

Becky has gone into Christmas mode and yes, we know it's October, but you need time to get your projects finished before the big day! So come along and join in the festivities and stitch an EPP Christmas cushion. Choose from a Festive tree or a Festive Hexi patchwork block.

Requirements:

We will be stitching with Christmas in mind! Choose from the following festive projects:

A **Scandi inspired tree** suitable to make into a cushion.

- A kit will be available on the day for purchase at a cost of £8.95.
- This will contain paper pieces, fabrics for the tree and fabrics for front and back of cushion. Front and back fabrics will be red.

or **A Candle Mat.**

- Kit available on the day to purchase at a cost of £5.95.
- These contain paper pieces, fabrics, wadding and calico for backing. Four designs to choose from (subject to availability).

Alternatively, you are welcome to bring your own project to work on. Becky will contact you prior to the class to discuss what you would like to do.

For all projects you will also need the following items:

- Piecing thread. Aurifil 50wt is recommended and in a neutral colour such as light grey. If you are unsure ask Becky in the class.
- Tacking or old machine thread for basting.
- A needle for tacking (such as an embroidery size 5) or Sewline glue pen if you prefer glue basting.
- Small size binding clips or plastic covered paper clips

The following items are also useful to bring should you already have them:

- Small cutting mat
- Fabric scissors
- Marking pencil or fabric marker

**All materials, except for paperclips, are available to purchase in the shop.*

Please remember:

- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
