Class Description:

This modern take on a sampler quilt uses a variety of piecing techniques to make up the blocks. From half square triangles, flying geese tumbling blocks, log cabin and a Dresden plate. The blocks are simply joined together in columns and quilted using a quilt as you go technique.

Requirements:

- 6x 1/2m coordinating fabrics or 12 Fat Quarters
- 1.5m background fabric

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, cutting mat & acrylic ruler (6" by 24").
- Sewing machine: don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. **feet***, bobbins, **needles*** plus your manual & stitch guide (yes, power lead and foot pedal have been forgotten, do check you have yours!).

*** You will need a 1/4" foot and a walking foot for your sewing machine.**

- Threads for piecing
- Threads for quilting
- General sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc.)
- Notepad and propelling pencil

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
