Class Description:

Learn how to use fabrics and bias tape make this beauty. You will use a variety of techniques following Sue Thornborough's Peacock pattern (available to buy in the shop). Using a combination of applique, stained glass look and topstitching produces this striking effect.

Requirements:

- Your own copy of the **Stained Glass Peacock Pattern** by Sue Thornborough (£4.50, purchase as a printed copy from the shop)
- 50cm background fabric
- 8m Clover Quick Bias Tape: 6mm width in Gold
- 10" square white fabric
- Scraps of blue, greens, turquoise & purple fabrics in plain or small prints (or 6-8 Fat Quarters)
- 1m Heat n Bond Lite

Equipment:

- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- 1/4" foot and open toe foot for your sewing machine.
- Microtex (Sharp) 80/12 sewing machine needles
- 6"x24" acrylic ruler
- Threads for piecing
- Threads for quilting (gold colour)
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad, pen and a propelling pencil

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
