Class Description:

Using the Creative Grids Storm at Sea Ruler (available in the shop) Emma will guide you through making these blocks, including thinking about colour placement to highlight areas of the quilt.

Fabric & Materials Requirements:

- ½ m each of 6 shades of blue from light to dark
- 1.2m dark blue (this needs to be darker than the others) or 70cm dark blue and 50cm bright colour for hearts
- 2m white or cream for background
- Wadding, backing and binding measure your finished quilt top to determine how much you need.
- Neutral thread for piecing (cream of grey are ideal)

Equipment:

- Creative Grids "Storm at Sea" Ruler
- Rotary cutter, large cutting mat & 24" acrylic ruler
- Sewing machine (don't forget foot pedal, power lead and accessories e.g. feet, bobbins, needles plus your manual).
- Basic sewing kit (scissors, hand needles, thread snips, unpicker, pins, etc)
- Notepad and pen

Please remember:

- We have 6 sewing machines (Janome M100 QDC) for hire; if you would like to hire one for this class, please do book one in advance – they are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The windows may be opened periodically during the class to allow for adequate ventilation.
- To bring your own equipment where possible.
