## Tomten's Winter Quilt



Approx. finished size 37 " wide by 60 "

## Fabrics requirements:

Fabric $1 \quad$ Panel - featuring 21 squares
Fabric $2 \quad 1 / 2 \mathrm{~m}$ white with silver snowflakes
Fabric 3 1m stars on dark navy
Fabric $4 \quad 1 \mathrm{~m}$ border scene

## Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1 Cut each square from the panel - I cut them $1 / 4$ " bigger than the actual square so that I didn't lose anything when adding the borders. Chose 1 NOT to use.

## Fabric 2 Cut 1" strips

Fabric 3 Cut $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips
Fabric 4 You can't cut this until you have completed the instructions to stage 7. Cut the border scene and 6 " above for the bottom piece and the scene and $1 / 4$ " above for the top one, both to the width of your quilt top in stage 7 .

## Instructions;

1. Take the $1^{\prime \prime}$ strips and cut 40 pieces from these strips to the same size as your squares from the panel. Add these to both sides of each square and press.
2. Measure the width of this new block and cut 40 pieces from the 1 " strips to this size. Add these to the top and bottom of each square and press.
3. Lay out the blocks to a pattern you like, bearing in mind to mix up the similar blocks throughout the quilt.
4. Measure the width of the block and cut 16 pieces from fabric 3 strips to this size. Add these to the bottom of the first 4 rows of blocks and press. Then join the blocks together in columns and press.
5. Measure the height of the column and cut 3 strips of fabric 3 to this size. Add to the right of columns 1,2 and 3 and press.
6. Join the columns together to make the centre of the quilt top.
7. Measure the height of the quilt and cut 2 pieces 4 " wide from fabric 3 , add these to either side of the quilt and press well.
8. Measure the width of the quilt and cut $12 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strip from fabric 3 for the top of the quilt. Add to the quilt and press.
9. Using the measurement in point 9 cut the border scene pieces as described above.
10.Add these to the top and bottom of the quilt

Your quilt top is now finished, and you can layer, quilt and bind it. Happy Sewing! ©Emma Randall July 2020
