Tomten Tree Quilt

(finished size approx. 38" by 54")

Fabric requirements

1 Tomten 21 squares Panel1m Navy Linen Texture1m Tomten Double Edge Border

Wadding, backing and binding - measure your finished quilt top to determine how much you need.

All seams should be sewn 1/4"

Workshop Notes

- 1. Cut the 21 pictures from the panel to measure 5½" squares.
- 2. From the Navy Linen Texture cut 6 strips at 1% and 1 strip at 2% and put to one side.
- 3. From the Navy Linen Texture cut 4 strips 5 ½ " wide.
- 4. Sub cut the following rectangles:

Tip - Cut all the larger pieces first as you can cut the 1½" pieces from the leftovers.

5. Lay out your pieces as per the diagram (this is not to scale!) then sew all the pieces in each row together.

- 6. Press all the seams to the left of the rows.
- 7. Sew a 1½" strip to the bottom of rows 1 to 5 and press seams towards the narrower strip (down).
- 8. Trim so that they line up with the rows.
- 9. Sew together row 1 and 2, 3 and 4, 5 and 6.
- 10. Sew Row 1-2 to 3-4.
- 11. Sew 1-2-3-4 to 5-6.
- 12. Sew the 2½" strip to the TOP of Row 1.
- 13. Press all seams towards bottom row.
- 14. Cut one of the borders from the border strip at approx. 16.5" and sew to the bottom of the quilt.
- 15. Trim the sides to fit the quilt.

Give your project a final good press!

You are now ready to layer, quilt and bind your quilt.
